Session Two

Scripture: John 13:12-17

Song: “Make Me a Servant” (TFWS #2176)

Reading: My God, I lift my face toward you now like a hungry child asking to be fed. My soul is starved; my flesh yearns for the touch that only you can give. Come to me, O God, stay with me; I abandon myself into your hands. Do with me as you will, and whatever you do with me, I thank you.
